



Farm School Gear List

What to Wear:

- Dress for dirt! Stratford is a working farm.
- Wear weather appropriate clothing. We will go out in light rain so a rain jacket or a poncho is helpful. Check the forecast!
- Long pants are recommended but not required. Poison ivy can be abundant! Use your own discretion based on your child's sensitivity.
- Comfortable shoes or boots. Sandals are not recommended as we will be running and hiking. Poison ivy loves uncovered toes! Please encourage your child to wear shoes they don't mind getting muddy or wet.

You Need to Bring:

- A face covering
- A no-garbage lunch (see instructions on our website)
- Water bottle
- **REMEMBER:** Bring your completed emergency health form and your daily health check/drop off/pick up form with you in the morning

Recommended:

- A backpack for their gear
- Mosquito repellent
- Sunscreen
- A sun hat
- A change of clothes (especially socks) in case your child gets wet
- A jacket for cool mornings
- A picnic blanket
