



## Information about Farm School & COVID 19

### Cancellations/Refunds:

Please be prepared for last minute cancellations due to COVID. If a participant or anyone on Stratford Staff tests positive for COVID we will close for deep cleaning and for the necessary quarantine timeframe. Full refunds will be given if we cancel your session. We will also give you a full refund if you have to cancel due to COVID exposure. Please give us as much notice as possible so we can give someone on our wait list a call.

### Health Precautions:

- All local and state health guidelines regarding COVID 19 will be followed. Hand washing will be done frequently throughout the day and in between activities. Children (6+) and instructors will be asked to wear masks when indoors. Masks will be encouraged for preschoolers when they are indoors, but it is at the parent's discretion and the child's comfort level.
- Adults & children at Stratford must stay home if experiencing one or more of the following symptoms. We ask parents to do a daily health assessment prior to coming to Stratford.
  - Cough
  - Shortness of breath
  - Difficulty breathing
  - Loss of Taste
  - Fever
  - Chills
  - Headache
  - Sore throat
  - Nausea
  - Fatigue congestion
  - Runny nose
- Students experiencing COVID 19 symptoms at farm school will be moved to a supervised area where they are isolated from other students. Parents will be contacted, and the child must be picked up promptly. Stratford will notify the Dept. of Job & Family Services in writing if a positive COVID-19 test is found in a child or employee.
- Students and staff will socially distance during lunch when eating indoors.

### Facilities:

- All facilities used by Farm School (restrooms, classroom, doors) will be professionally cleaned twice a week. Stratford staff will also clean throughout the day as appropriate.
