



Farm School Gear List

What to Wear:

- Dress for dirt! Stratford is a working farm.
- Wear weather appropriate clothing. We will go out in light rain so a rain jacket or a poncho is helpful. Check the forecast!
- Long pants are recommended but not required. Poison ivy can be abundant! Use your own discretion based on your child's sensitivity.
- Comfortable shoes or boots. Sandals are not recommended as we will be running and hiking. Poison ivy loves uncovered toes! Please encourage your child to wear shoes they don't mind getting muddy or wet.

What to Bring:

- A trash-free lunch for 6-12 year olds (see instructions on our website)
- A trash-free snack for 4-5 year olds(see instructions on our website)
 - You're welcome to pack a picnic lunch to enjoy with your farm preschooler after noon pick-up if you'd like
- Water bottle
- Backpack for their gear
- Mosquito repellent
- Sunscreen (if weather called for it)
- A sun hat or winter hat based on the forecast
- A change of clothes (especially socks) in case your child gets wet/dirty
- A bag for wet/dirty clothes
- A jacket for cool mornings
- A journal (if you already have one - no need to buy something new)
